Combined Test Divisions

1. Tadpole- USDF Intro Test A, small arena, poles on ground, no time
2. Green as Grass- USDF Intro Test B, small arena, 18" cross rails, no time
3. Intro Eventer- Beg Novice Test A, small arena, 2' jumps, no time
4. Beginner Novice- Beg Nov Test A, small arena, 2'6" jumps
5. Novice- Novice Test B, small arena, 2'11" jumps
6. Training- Training Test B, small arena, 3'3" jumps
7. Preliminary- Prelim Test B, small arena, 3'7" jumps
8. Intermediate- Intermediate Test B, large arena, 3'11" jumps

Rules & Regulations

Classes will be placed AA, Jr/YR and Open

Entries open 3 weeks prior the show date, entries close the Tuesday before the show.

- Regarding classes 1-8, riders may add a dressage test AFTER they've ridden their CT competition ride and before they jump.

- * Classes 26-30 more than one test may be ridden, clearly state test(s) to be ridden on entry form.

- All USEF/USDF dressage tests to be ridden in a plain snaffle, except Third Level or above, full bridle optional

- A negative Coggins test within the previous 12 months must be presented with entry onto the premises

- RIDE TIMES: will be available the Thursday before the show on Facebook and www.riohorseshow.com

- CANCELLATION POLICY: entries may be cancelled for a refund, minus \$20 office fee up to 3 days prior the show, after that, a refund minus \$20 office fee may be applied to your next show at RIO Equestrian Centre

- Except where otherwise noted, USEF/USDF, WDAA and MHSA rules will apply

*** ASTM/SEI approved helmet must be worn at all times when mounted**

Fees

Dressage Classes (each):\$25.00 (max. 3 tests/horse/day)

Combined Test:.....\$55.00

Office fee per horse:..... \$20.00

Jump Out fee per entry..... \$25.00 (horses without stalls)

Non-Showing horse:.....\$25/day or \$40.00/weekend

Stall:..... \$40.00/one night or, \$75.00/ weekend

Stall Set-up (optional).....\$10.00

Turnout paddock: \$100.00/weekend

Stabling: 200 permanent stalls available, matted, 10' x 12'

***Horses can move in at or after noon on Friday, schooling opens at 3pm**
